

This project was actually quite simple but with a large impact. As the Year of the Priests drew to a close, the Council wanted to recognize the priests for their service. For this, the Council had a note put in each of the Church bulletins; St Francis, St Martin's, and St Mary's. A copy of the note from the St Mary's Bulletin is attached.

Knights who are members of St Mary's took an additional step and hosted coffee and donuts after the 10:30 AM mass. Due to logistical problems with traffic, the Pastor requested that we host donuts after this Mass only. Twelve dozen donuts picked up by Brother John Leighton, and fresh coffee made by Brother Chuck Durbin, were available just after Mass. The donuts were devoured within 10 minutes by the approximately 200 parishoners who stopped by after Mass at the Parish Community Room, adjacent to the Church. Many youth and adults came to look at our tri-fold, with great positive impact. The priests of St Mary's who were able to attend the after-mass social were very appreciative that their efforts were recognized and that many parishioners had stopped by after the Mass to offer thanks as well.

The hours that went into this program were few – about 10 Knights who attended the mass also participated in the coffee and donuts, and the effort to pick up donuts and make coffee were minimal. However, Supreme Knight Carl Anderson has stated that “For the K of C the year for priests is every year. We will never stop praying and supporting our bishops and priests for whom we are grateful to God because of their holy lives and their pastoral care of the Church.” For this reason, and the simplicity of the event, the Council will again host in the spring another Thank You.
